RESPECT FOR TEAMMATES AND COACHES

- Show respect for teammates and their roles within the team

RESPECT THE COACHES AND OFFICIALS

- Trust and support the coaches’ decisions and methods
- Refrain from coaching your child or others from the sidelines during training or matches
- Respect referees and officials, accepting their decisions without confrontation

MANAGE YOUR ROLE DURING MATCHES

- Remain in the designated spectator areas and avoid entering the field under any circumstances.
- Refrain from coaching from the sidelines, leave technical instruction to the appointed coaches.
- Avoid directing comments toward “players”, coaches and opposition team during matches
- Always treat the referee with respect, regardless of their decisions.
- Focus on enjoying the game and celebrating “players” efforts and achievements

PITCH INVASION

It is strictly forbidden for parents or supporters to enter the field at any time. Entering the pitch constitutes a pitch invasion and will incur a fine of R5000.00 per individual from Easterns directly. Each parent will be liable to pay their own fine.

DISPLAY GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP AND FOSTERING A POSITIVE TEAM ENVIRONMENT

- Avoid negative comments, inappropriate language, or actions that could disrupt the game or team morale
- Cheer for all “players”, including the opposing team, in a spirit of fairness and positivity
- Promote inclusivity and respect for all team members, regardless of skill level, background, or role
- Avoid gossip, criticism, or negativity that could harm the team dynamic
- Support team goals and values, encouraging unity and cooperation

ADHERE TO CLUB POLICIES

- Follow all rules and guidelines set forth by the club, team and league
- Ensure your child is punctual for practices, matches and team events
- Communicate with coaches or team management respectfully regarding any concerns or issues

PROMOTE A SAFE AND RESPECTFUL ENVIRONMENT

- Ensure your child is well-rested, hydrated and prepared for training and matches
- Refrain from any behaviour that could endanger the safety or well-being of “players” or others
- Report any instances of bullying, discrimination or inappropriate conduct to team management

STRICTLY NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

Alcohol is strictly prohibited on TFI home grounds. This rule is mandated by the Department of Education, as our club is based on school property. Any individual found bringing or consuming alcohol on the premises will be subject to a R1000.00 fine.

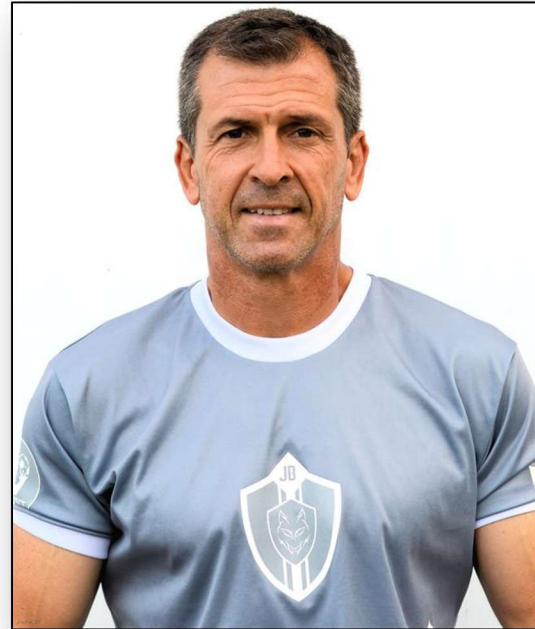

TFI | COMPLEMENTING TEAM AND CLUB TRAINING

Football team training covers a range of aspects like tactical plays, team cohesion, and match-specific strategies. However, individual players often have limited time to focus on detailed technical training within the team setup.

This is where our individual technical training proves its worth. It offers players dedicated time to enhance specific skills and techniques that may not get sufficient attention during team sessions. This personalized approach targets each player's unique strengths and weaknesses.

By combining both club-based team training and our TFI program for individual training, players can experience a more balanced development. Team training emphasizes collective performance and tactics, while individual training fine-tunes a player's technical abilities and areas needing improvement. This dual approach contributes to shaping a more well-rounded and skilled player.



TFI | RECREATING STREET FOOTBALL

Individual training serves as a contemporary counterpart to the traditional practice of street football, a form long lauded for its ability to foster close ball control and improvisational skills. Johan Cruyff, a legendary figure in football, emphasized the importance of spending time playing street football. It's in these unstructured, often confined spaces that players are forced to make quick decisions, use their creativity, and develop a close affinity with the ball.

However, individual training brings its own set of advantages. This structured approach proves advantageous for refining and honing skills to an exceptional level of precision.

By combining street football environment with individual technical training in our sessions, players can leverage the best of both worlds. Street football fosters an innate, instinctive feel for the game, while individual training facilitates targeted refinement and improvement of specific technical aspects. Together, these components contribute to shaping a well-rounded player endowed with a profound and adaptable skill set.



TFI | CONSTANT CONTACT WITH THE BALL



Engaging in individual training allows players to dedicate focused time to the ball, refining their first touch, dribbling, and close control.

This repetitive practice fosters a closer connection with the ball, enhancing players' confidence and skills during matches.

The program involves using various footballs of different sizes and weights, introducing challenges with balls from sports like tennis and rugby.

Johan Cruyff's influential emphasis on ball mastery and control is integrated into our coaching. He believed that a player's touch was fundamental to on-field performance.

Attention to detail

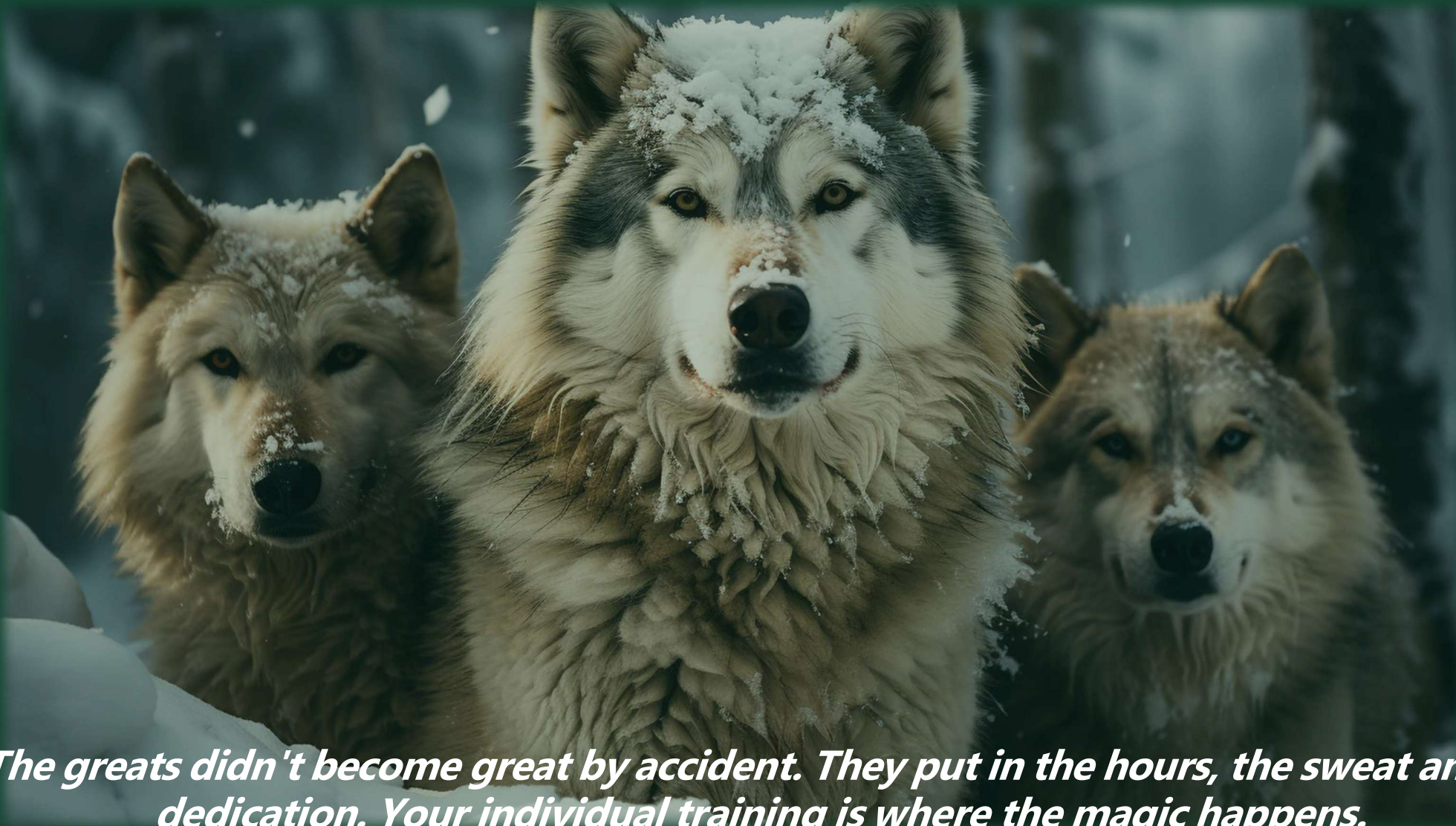
Coaches can pay close attention to the finer details of a player's technique, making adjustments and refinements that may go unnoticed in a larger group setting
